- There were 361 complaints from August 16<sup>th</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010.
- 225 (62.33%) of the complaints were self-generated.
- The three biggest areas of concern seem to be the Traffic Bylaw (97-07), the Nuisance Bylaw (2005-13) and the Dog Control Bylaw (2006-07).

#### Issues/Focus for 2011

- Nuisance properties, especially graffiti, maintenance of alleys and uncut grass.
- Abandoned vehicles.
- Unattached trailers.
- Overgrown and unmaintained trees.
- Dogs/cats at large and unlicensed dogs/cats.
- Garbage not being bagged or put into bins, including improper receptacles.
- Unlicensed home-based businesses and contractors in Wainwright.
- OHV's in the Hwy. 14 ditches and in the Town's parks and green spaces.
- Peace officer training for OHV enforcement and animal control enforcement.
- Updating existing bylaws and creating new bylaws.
