4. WR161300-1 - AMMO COMPOUND FIRE ALARM REPAIR, (WITH SECURITY REQUIREMENTS)

Purpose of this Advance Procurement Notice

This is not a bid solicitation. This is an advance notice of a potential project with anticipated security requirements to provide interested contractors an opportunity to apply for security clearances. Note that there is no guarantee that this project will proceed.

Description of the Project

The main objective of this project is to ensure that the fire alarm life safety system within the Ammo Compound at 3CDSB Wainwright is reliable and maintainable. It is intended to provide a one-for-one replacement of obsolete and failing components (signaling and detection devices, fire alarm panels and communications network) necessary to maintain the current level of fire protection within the Ammo Compound.

Description of the Services

The contractor will be required to replace the existing Fire Alarm System detection devices and fire alarm panels in 23 buildings within the Ammo Compound, configure them as a large scale network and provide a head end receiving solution to receive the fire alarm signals from the Ammo Compound and deliver them to the existing Bell XWave Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) monitoring station at the base Fire Hall. The estimated value of this work is \$470,000.00. It is anticipated that this contract will be procured in November 2017. This is conditional on the project receiving approval to proceed by the Department of National Defence (DND).

Security Requirements

Contractors will be required to hold a valid FACILITY SECURITY CLEARANCE (FSC) at the level of SECRET, issued or approved by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).

Sub-contractors will be required to hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS) and personnel must each hold a valid RELIABILITY STATUS. Personnel requiring access to sensitive work site(s) will be required to hold a valid FACILITY SECURITY CLEARANCE (FSC) at the level of SECRET issued or approved by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).

5. CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 17/18 (WITH SECURITY REQUIREMENTS)

Purpose of this Advance Procurement Notice

This is not a bid solicitation. This is an advance notice of potential projects with anticipated security requirements to provide interested consultants and contractors an opportunity to apply for security clearances. Note that there is no guarantee that these projects will proceed.

Description of the Program

The Construction Program will consist of multi-trade and single trade, construction projects of varying sizes and complexity. The program may include, but is not limited to new construction, repair, renovations and maintenance of Department of National Defence (DND) infrastructure in support of Canadian Forces Operations.

Additional technical services supporting the program may also include, but not limited to land surveying, materials testing, geological and environmental studies, and architectural and engineering design services.

Overall program value is estimated at \$14,000,000.00, with the maximum value of any individual project \$3,000,000.00.

Description of the Services

The program will consist of design and construction projects that may include, but are not necessarily limited to the following:

- General construction services including design, repairs, expansions, and/or replacements of partial and complete facilities, including siding, roofing, flooring in various facilities and the construction of complete new facilities.
- Electrical and Control systems repair and/or replacements including electrical distribution systems, primary service installations, diesel generators, and other building related electrical components including fire detection.
- Mechanical systems repair and/or replacements including supply and installation of heating, air conditioning and ventilation systems, sprinkler and plumbing services, fire protection services and building management control systems.
- Specialized services for the installation of security fencing and automatic gates, hazardous materials abatement, garage and overhead doors, fuel tank and related piping/accessory replacements, and inspections of various building architectural, structural, and other engineering services.
- Civil Works to include the construction of roadways, re-paving existing roadways, new curbing and gutters, new concrete installations and utilities corridors, in-ground/above ground electrical installations, shore-line and drainage erosion control and various other works of a civil nature.

It is anticipated that the procurement for these projects will be initiated in the period of April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018. This is conditional on the projects receiving approval to proceed by DND.
