

TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT

BYLAW NO. 98 - 07

A Bylaw of the Town of Wainwright in the Province of Alberta, to provide that if prior to the opening of the voting stations on election day a candidate for an elected authority dies after being nominated, that the election for the position to which the deceased candidate was nominated be discontinued until practicable to provide for the holding of a new election for that office.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 33(1) of the Local Authorities Election Act, being chapter L27.5 of the Revised Statues of Alberta, 1983 with amendments thereto, a Municipal Council may pass a bylaw to discontinue an election when a candidate dies prior to the opening of the voting stations.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Wainwright in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Local Authorities Election Act, does hereby enact as follows:

That if prior to the opening of the voting stations on election day a candidate nominated for an elected authority dies, the election for the position to which the deceased candidate was nominated be discontinued and the elected authority shall as soon as practicable provide for the holding of a new election for that office.

This Bylaw shall come into effect on the final passing.




