

TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT

BYLAW NO. 98 - 06

A Bylaw of the Town of Wainwright in the Province of Alberta, requiring that each candidate running for Council provide a deposit with their Nomination papers.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 29 of the Local Authorities Election Act, being Chapter L27.5 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1983 with amendments thereto, a Municipal Council may pass a bylaw requiring a deposit accompany their nomination papers.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Wainwright in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Local Authorities Election Act, does hereby enact as follows:

1. Any person, submitting a nomination paper to let their name stand for the position of Mayor or Councillor for the Town of Wainwright, must provide a deposit in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) with their nomination papers.
2. The Returning Officer shall require the deposit as set out in Section 1 be provided in cash, by certified cheque, or by money order.
3. The Candidate's deposit as set out in Section 1 will be returned if the requirements of the Local Authority Election Act are met.

This Bylaw shall come into effect on the final passing.


