### POLICY STATEMENT:

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines and a fee structure for the operation of the Peace Memorial Multiplex climbing wall.

### PROCEDURES:

That effective August 1, 2006 the following guidelines and fee structure will be established for the operation of the Peace Memorial Multiplex climbing wall:

#### WALL OPERATION

1. Climbers must use chalk bags. No loose chalk will be permitted.
2. All climbers using the wall must have signed a waiver and completed a belay check at the Town's facility. An alphabetical listing of individuals who have signed waivers will be maintained at the Wainwright & District Communiplex Pool office. Climbing instructors will maintain a card system on belay checks in the Peace Memorial Multiplex office.
3. The minimum age for a climber is six (6) years old.
4. Lead climbing and repelling on the wall is prohibited.

5. The gri gri is the only belay device permitted for use on the wall.
6. Bouldering age limits
  - Adults no hands allowed above the top of the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) panel from the floor, and
  - Child, ages six to fourteen (6-14) years old, no hands allowed above the top of the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) panel from the floor.
7. Maximum number of climbers on the wall at any one time is twelve (12); six (6) climbers and six (6) belayers.
8. No bare feet permitted on the carpeted area.
9. No climbing in bare feet or socks. All shoes must have non-marking soles and be clean prior to climbing.
10. Outside ropes are not allowed for use in the climbing facility.
11. Food, gum and open water bottles are not permitted on the carpeted area.
12. The minimum age for belaying is fourteen (14) years old. The instructor will make the final decision as to whether or not the individual is mature and attentive enough to allow them to belay.
13. During the hours of open climbing the first in first out rule will apply based on one and a half (1 ½) hours of climbing.
14. Climbers are required to avoid climbing routes that will interfere with others already on the climbing wall.
15. Swinging on the ropes is not permitted.
16. All rings must be removed prior to climbing.
17. Climbing shirtless is not permitted.
18. The staff reserves the right to reject homemade equipment or equipment deemed unsafe.
19. The staff reserves the right to remove the climbing privileges of any individuals for conduct that is deemed unsafe and/or inappropriate.

20. Bouldering is permitted during open climbing, provided that a climber using a rope is at least two (2) panels above the boulderer. Climbers on ropes have the right of way on the wall.
