



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

In preparation for the upcoming 100th anniversary of the Memorial Clock Tower occurring on Saturday, September 13, 2025, the Town of Wainwright has contracted Scorpio Masonry to restore the monument. Over the years, the clock tower has experienced wear due to exposure to harsh weather and natural aging processes. Restoration will stabilize and protect the structure while also restoring its original appearance and maintaining its role as a cultural and historical symbol for future generations.

Below is the tentative schedule for restoration construction of the Memorial Clock Tower, barring weather and unforeseen circumstances:

- **Beginning Tuesday, April 22, 2025**
- **Ending by mid-June, 2025**

During the project

- Barricades, fencing and scaffolding will be set up around the clock tower.
- Access will still be available on Main Street for most vehicles.
- Large vehicles e.g. semis, oversized vehicles, trucks with trailers, will not be allowed through the intersection and these vehicles will not have access around the clock tower during construction.
- Please note that complete closure of the intersection and road may occur throughout the project.
- Hours of construction are expected to be from 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday.
- Some noise from the project is anticipated.

How can you help?

- Respect and follow posted signs and barricades.
- Slow down when driving around the clock tower and be mindful of the workers.
- Report issues, if you notice any safety concerns or issues related to the construction area, such as damaged signs or unsafe conditions.
