Fall Clean-Up Week Oct 7 - 13, 2024

Residents are encouraged to conduct their yard clean up during the week of Oct 7 to Oct 13 and place sorted wastes such as earth, sod and grass clippings in clear plastic bags in the back alley as usual for collection. Tree branches must be cut to a reasonable length and stacked for ease of pick up. The Public Works Department will pick up these wastes from residential properties

(excluding apartments) during the week of Oct 15 to 18, 2024.

1ST AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS

Hamm Construction is continuing operations on the Town of Wainwright 1st Avenue Improvements, extending from the 1st Street off-ramp to 8th Street.

Hamm Construction's focus will be on conducting sanitary upgrades. Following sanitary upgrades, Border Paving will undertake road resurfacing. Hamm Construction's and Border Paving's scopes of work will necessitate road closures beginning on July 2, 2024 with full access anticipated to be reinstated by mid-October, 2024.

WHAT: Town Of Wainwright 1st Avenue Improvements

WHEN: July 2nd, 2024, to mid-October, 2024

WHERE: 1st Avenue, from 1st Street to 8th Street

- On behalf of the Town of Wainwright, Hamm Construction is slated to commence operations on 1st Avenue, extending from the 1st Street off-ramp to 8th Street. Hamm Construction's focus will be on conducting sanitary upgrades. Following sanitary upgrades, Border Paving will undertake road resurfacing. Hamm Construction's and Border Paving's scopes of work will necessitate road closures beginning on **July 2nd, 2024** with full access anticipated to be reinstated by **mid-October, 2024**.

During this project

- Once construction begins, the intersection and roadway will be closed, and detours implemented.
- Work will be phased to minimize disruptions to the area for businesses and residents.
- Temporary access will be provided once base gravel is laid in certain stretches.
- Below is the **tentative schedule** for the work, barring weather delays and unforeseen circumstances:
 - **Beginning - July 2nd, 2024**
 - **Ending - mid-October, 2024**
- Once work begins on each phase, heavy equipment will be required to complete this work. Some noise and vibration are anticipated.
- During our 10-day shift, our working hours will be from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. A detailed shift schedule can be provided if requested.

How you can help

- Follow posted traffic detours.
- Respect posted signs and barricades.
- Anticipate delays or changes in traffic patterns due to construction activities and plan your routes accordingly.
- Stay clear of the work zone for your safety and the safety of workers.
- Report issues, if you notice any safety concerns or issues related to the construction site, such as damaged signs or unsafe conditions, please contact Hamm Construction at 306 380 0780.

Common Questions



Will there be traffic and street/driveway access restrictions?

Wherever work is happening, roads and sections of sidewalks will be closed. You may have to park several blocks away, and even if work isn't happening on your block, you may notice more people walking, driving, and parking on your street because of the nearby closures.



The traffic plan for the construction project outlines a series of phased actions aimed at efficiently managing access. Initially, attention will be directed to the stretch from 1st Street to 5th Street. Here, activities will involve completing the sanitary scope, conducting concrete work, and laying base gravel. Temporary access will be granted from 1st Street to 5th Street after the base gravel is laid. However, access will subsequently close again, with full access restored once asphalt is laid on the same stretch. This approach ensures a systematic progression of work while minimizing disruptions to traffic flow.

2024 PROPERTY INSPECTIONS

This notice is to inform Town of Wainwright ratepayers that re-inspection of properties for assessment purposes will commence May 1, 2024.

Inspections will be done by Wainwright Assessment Group Ltd. and will be completed around the end of December 2024.

Assessors will be on site and show I.D. when occupants are present and leave notes in doors and proceed with an exterior inspection when no one is at the property.

DOWNTOWN VACANT SPACES INCENTIVE

The Downtown Vacant Spaces Incentive is a limited pilot program designed to provide up to \$2,500.00 in start-up costs for entrepreneurs to activate vacant street-level commercial spaces in the C1 - Commercial Central

District.

The incentive is available to businesses that take occupancy of a commercial space that has been vacant for at least three (3) months.

Funding to a maximum of \$2,500.00 per successful application may be used to cover 50% of eligible startup costs.
