Qualifications for Membership Application

Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Wainwright Fire Rescue Department. To be considered for a position with the Department the following criteria will be assessed:

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Reside within a reasonable travel distance to the fire hall. This distance radius is determined and reviewed by Command Staff and is updated in department guidelines as necessary.
- 2. Be at least 18 years of age.
- 3. Complete and submit a Department application form available at <u>www.wainwright.ca</u>, including references.
- 4. Hold a valid class 5 Alberta Operators license.
- 5. Provide a drivers license abstract on request.
- 6. Participate in physical testing as required.
- 7. Be physically fit to the level required to perform all functions, tasks, and/ or otherwise of a firefighter. (A medical examination may be requested, any costs involved to be borne by the candidate).
- 8. Provide a current, within 30days, Criminal Records check from the RCMP and/ or other accredited Police Agency.

ASSET QUALIFICATIONS:

- 9. Hold a current standard first aid certificate with level "C" CPR, current within one year of issue.
- 10. Hold a valid Class 5 Alberta Operator's license with "Q" air brake endorsement.
- 11. Hold a valid Class 3 Alberta Operators license with "Q" air brake endorsement.
- 12. Submit a current resume on request.
