"Your summer get-away within Town limits!" **1. Camping-** A Camping Permit is required for overnight camping and is to be pre-paid at time of registration to guarantee your booking. The permit holder is responsible for all actions of visitors and camping party members on the campsite. These permits are non-transferable. You must immediately occupy the campsite designated by the permit.

Cancellations must be received by the Manager 24 hours in advance of the booking time or the site will be subject to a 1 night's charge. Reserved sites will be held until 7pm the day of the reservation. A single night's charge will be applied to the credit card after 7pm and the site may be allocated to another user.

•A maximum of four (4) people per campsite is allowed, except where your immediate family is larger. Only one RV is allowed and no more than 2 nonlivable vehicles per site.

• Check-out time is 12:00pm.

• Visitors should park in designated parking areas only and must leave the campground by 11:00 P.M.

• Campfires are permitted only in the facilities provided for that purpose. Please make sure your fire is out before you leave. Never leave campfires unattended, and children must be accompanied by an adult.

•Wastewater or basin draining must be disposed of in receptacles or sewer drains provided. \cdot Please keep our campsite free of litter, put all trash in dumpsters, break down boxes to conserve space.

• Quiethours in the park are observed from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. No objectionable disturbance or unreasonable noise will be allowed at any time.

• Tenting sites are 14-day maximum stay.

• Alcohol and Cannabis consumption are only permitted in your rented camping stall and not in any public areas (street, playground, etc).

2. Day Use Area - These areas are open from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. daily. No liquor is allowed in picnic or other public areas. Please keep this area clean and remember to take all of your belongings with you.

8. Internet Access – wireless access available by an off-site external provider. We will provide interested campers with a user-name and password for a predetermined length of access time.

9. Propane Tank Usage – Limit to 100 lb maximum per site. Cylinders larger than 100 lb are not permitted
